The PromCom accepts your record on good faith but reserves the right to require proof of the information supplied. Recommended applicants become promoted with the simple majority approval of the

Annual Participants Assembly (February). The Assembly votes on your promotion only when you are attending the meeting; ie your presence is required for this vote. Should your application be rejected by the simple majority vote of either the PromCom or the Annual Assembly, you may re-apply for the forthcoming year.
