He lived for many years in New York City, Washington, D.C. and Sao Paulo, Brazil, and traveled extensively for most of his adult life before moving to the central part of the United States in Louisville, Kentucky. He currently teaches at Bellarmine University and maintains a private practice in that city. His research has focused on Carl Jung's 26 year relationship with the Nobel laureate, Wolfgang Pauli.
